

## How to Measure Your Existing Shirt

### Step 1 - Collar



Lay the shirt flat and measure from the collar button to the buttonhole.

### Step 2 - Chest



Lay the shirt flat (buttoned) and measure from one underarm to the other.

### Step 3 - Waist



Lay the shirt flat (buttoned) and measure across the narrowest part of the shirt at the waistline.

## How to Measure Your Existing Shirt - Continued

### Step 4 - Bottom



Lay the shirt flat (buttoned) and measure from one of the bottom seams to the other.

### Step 5 - Sleeves



Lay the sleeve flat and measure from the top of the shoulder to the end of the cuff.

### Step 6 - Sleeve Width



Lay the sleeve flat and measure across the sleeve.

## How to Measure Your Existing Shirt - Continued

### Step 7 - Cuffs



Place the cuff on a flat surface. Place the measuring tape on the outer edge of the button hole and measure across to the center of the button.

### Step 8 - Back



Lay the shirt flat (buttoned) on it's front and measure from one edge of the shoulder to the other.

### Step 9 - Shoulder



Lay the shirt flat (buttoned) on it's front and measure from the edge of the collar to the edge of the shoulder.

## How to Measure Your Existing Shirt - Continued

### Step 10 - Length



Lay the shirt flat (buttoned) on it's front and measure from the bottom of the collar to the base of the shirt.
